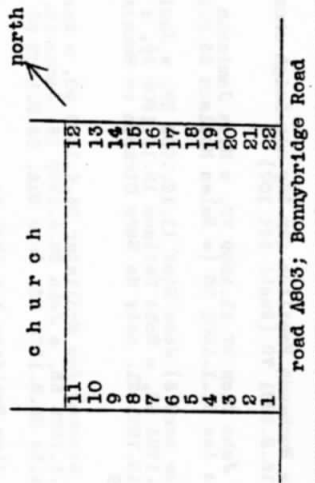


All inscriptions.
