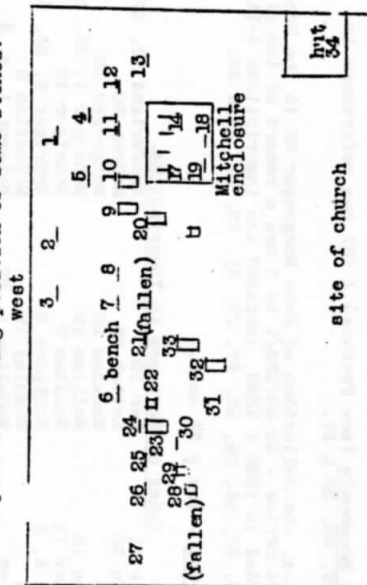


All inscriptions.

National Grid Reference NS 410696; on a small uninhabited island in Loch Lomond. (Inchailloch); ferry from Balmaha. Surveyed July 1969.

JGS (see Preface) the parish of Buchanan was originally called
Buchanan and the parish church was on the island - see p 32
ante (p 98 et seq of JGS); reference is made to inscriptions
20 & 33, and for inscription 23 it has "this is appointed
for the burying place of Duncan M'Farlane and Katharine
M'Grigor in Inchfrade and their children 1783"

Ancient Monuments (see Preface) 1 167 has references to
20, 33, 35, 36 & 37.

JMCG, i.e. the collection of John Macgregor WS in the Scottish
Record Office - GD 50/233/1 to 3 has a record of inscriptions
recorded in 1885 & 1889. Included are inscriptions 4-11,
14-18, 20, 23, 24, 26, 27, 29, 31, 33, 37, 38 & 39.
